

## ***What To Bring***

*Casual clothes are fine – but – policies prohibit clothes which promote use of tobacco, alcohol or lewd behaviors. And – clothes must fit appropriately; if not, counselors will respectfully request youth to change their clothes.*

### ***Here's what you'll need to survive:***

- A love for God & your Bible
- Spiral notebook, Pencil or Pen
- Sleeping gear (sleeping bag, sheets, pillow, etc.)
- A fresh change of clothes for each day
- An extra change of clothes for rainy days
- 2 pair of shoes – ***sturdy shoes are important*** (sneakers, tennis style is fine)
- A warm smile
- Swim Suit (appropriate for a Christian community, please)
- Sunscreen & Sunglasses, a Hat & Insect Repellent
- Flashlight
- Soap, toiletries, Personal items
- Towels & Wash cloth (you may want a swim towel, too)
- An open mind
- Canteen Cards are sold at check-in \$1.50 per day limit! (see below)
- An offering for *Pennies For Mission*

**Warning... Most of the beds are “college length” – about 6” longer than a standard Twin. Fitted Jersey knit sheets can stretch to fit. Sleeping bags fit regardless of the mattress!**

### ***What NOT to Bring:***

- Cell Phones are not conducive to a Christian camp community experience! Please do not bring your cell! **Camp staff will collect cell phones**, put them away and return them at the end of the camp.
- Candy, Gum, or Snacks – **no food allowed in sleeping areas!** There is a Canteen in the afternoon for optional purchases (all products are .75 -- **\$1.50 is the daily limit**)
- Alcohol, controlled substances, firearms or tobacco products – these will not be tolerated, and there will be specific consequences for those who try to use these during camp.
- Lots of Cash or expensive Jewelry – these are not necessary, and caring for them can be a problem! The camp will not be responsible for broken or lost items of this sort!
