2010 Projects**

Dining Hall Upgrade:

- Chairs – 100 stacking chairs, blue - \$3500
- Landscape projects – see below

Furnishings:

- Lounge furniture (2 sofas, 2 side chairs, occasional tables) – for Great Room in the Sweden Leadership Lodge - \$4,500 (estimates). *Various pieces may be purchased according to a proposed price list.*
- Seminar tables (20” x 6’) for Great Room (12 needed) - \$1200 est.

Maintenance:

- A “new” Tractor
- An additional Golf Cart – to move individuals with limited walking ability will always be a need!

Others:

- Plants, Trees and Landscape work – various places
- Signs to identify buildings, program areas
- Prayer Walk – a path to the south will include nine stops, with a bench and a post including scripture/meditations at each.
- Sand Volleyball Court – efforts are needed to reposition the court, and design it to be maintenance-free.
- New paddle boats and canoes for use at the lake-front.
- Hand tools – good, used tools are always appreciated!

Landscape: Recognition Plaza and Drive-thru at the south entrance of Dining Hall.

Landscape design includes several phases to accomplish the entire plan – individuals or groups may be support the project in stages

- Entry Gathering Plaza and Walks (including shaded area) - \$25,000
- Circle Drive - \$25,000
- Recognition Plaza - \$20,000
- Landscape work - \$15,000
- Meditation Garden, south of new Chapel. Includes a shallow pond to focus on “Woman at the Well” story: *“whoever drinks of the water I give will never thirst again....”* (This project not in the \$75,000 estimate above.)

Outdoor Chapel – power and lights are an important next step; estimate \$5,000.

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Prayer Labyrinth – a basic design has been developed – estimates for materials are not yet complete. The Labyrinth is on the south side of the creek, and west of the main Fire Circle (south of the main campus). The design will include natural stone, bricks, and landscape stone-pavers to complete the project. A variety of individuals may participate in tasks to complete the project. This may cost **about \$10,000.**

Gazebo or “Program Pavilion” east of dining hall - \$45,000 (estimate)

- Roof and steel frame enclosure on 3 sides
- Rock façade
- North wall may include a Fireplace (for poor weather)
- Pavilion should seat up to 125 people in rows – will serve several needs

Volunteer Opportunities

- 1) Painting – a number of our spaces show evidence of use – and new paint would dress up the facilities. Accurate painters only – sorry, no youth groups!
- 2) Work on a new Sand Volleyball pit
- 3) Landscape work – and - Clearing dead trees, etc., at the south pasture
- 4) Carpenters (see above)
